

Registering in the Basisregistratie Personen (BRP)

People from Ukraine, who come en live in our town council, have to register in the so called Basisregistratie Personen (BRP). The Personal Records Database (BRP) contains the personal data of people who live in the Netherlands (residents) and of people who live abroad (non-residents). You can also register yourself if you are living at a holiday resort or another temporary address. People from Ukraine living at a private family do not affect any unemployment benefits or health care allowances that the private family gets from the government.

Living allowance

- People from Ukraine receive a living allowance; 260 € each person each month. This amount
 will be transferred to a Dutch bank account. If you don't have a Dutch bank account, we will
 pay the amount in advance each week. The amount in advance is 50 € for someone who is
 travelling alone. A parent receives 70 € each week and a couple receives 100 € each week.
- People from Ukraine who live in a private place (with another Dutch family for example) receive an extra so called housing contribution. With this contribution they can agree an amount for their stay with the household of this private place.

Bank account

A bank account is necessary to receive the living allowance or, when someone has a job, salary. You can open your bank account with the Regio Bank (there are offices in Oostburg and IJzendijke), at ING Bank (at the post office in Oostburg), or online at ABN-AMRO for example. You must provide your bank account to the council, so we can ensure that your living allowance will be transferred to your bank account.

To open an bank account you have to:

- Have a social security number (BSN)
- Give first name and last name
- Give date of birth, place of birth and gender
- Give nationality
- Give the address where you (temporary) live, phone number and e-mail
- Have a valid ID which has a ID-number, photo of youre face, biometric data, date of issue en place of issue

Town council debit card

People from Ukraine who do not have a valid ID cannot open a bank account. In that case someone can receive a special debit card form our town council. You can ask for this special debit car by sending an e-mail to oekraine@gemeentesluis.nl

Employment

Our Employment Service Centre Zeeuws-Vlaanderen (WSP-ZVL) provides people with actual information about the job market and can help people with their curriculum vitae. They also can help people to get a job. They mediate between employers and employees and they can support during the process of getting a labour contract. You can visit the WSP in the town council in Oostburg and people can make an appointment when they need help.

Health Insurance

Every person who has a job in the Netherlands has to get a health insurance. Without an health insurance you can get a fine. You make a health insurance contract by name/person. If you have a job and you earn a small amount, you probably can get a health care allowance. For that you need a so called DigiD. Medical costs

Necessary medical treatments are done by a CAK-declaration. Healthcare (a doctor or pharmacy) can decline the costs for necessary medical treatments by the so called CAK.

Dentist

Only very necessary treatments can be done with a CAK-declaration. Other treatments have to be paid by yourself. Ask the dentist if you have to pay the treatment yourself. If you do so, there are no surprises.

Public transport

People from Ukraine were able to use our public transport for free. This has changed. People from Ukraine only can travel free when they come to the Netherlands. When they are registered they can no longer use the Dutch public transport for free. The town council of Sluis has ordered for so called OV- chipkaarten. We will make an announcement in a newsletter when these cards are available.

Education

- Children at the age of 4-6 visit our TEC-school at Oostburg. If this is a problem the children can also visit the school where they live at that moment.
- Children at the age of 6-12 visit our TEC-school at Oostburg. You can apply your child by sending an e-mail to marcvanvlierberghe@elevantio.nl. The town council of Sluis will provide transportation.
- Children at the age 12-18 visit the EOA (Eerste Opvang Anderstaligen) at Terneuzen located at the Lodewijk college. You can read more about it at: Eerste Opvang Anderstaligen Lodewijk College. At the bottom of the webpage you find the information in English. You can apply your child by sending an e-mail to aanmeldingenEOA@lodewijkcollege.nl. The children travel by public transport to the location. The children receive an OV-chipkaart so they can travel free.

Sports and leisure

All people from Ukraine can visit one sports- and/or culture club. The clubs can declare the costs at the town council of Sluis.



Pets
